



<p>WHY MEXICO?</p> <p>In 1999, the El Niño community in Tijuana began because of heavy storms and flooding. The Mexican government bussed people that lost their homes into that area and gave them a small piece of property and a dwelling to start the community. Since then, thousands of Refugees find open land and build with recycled garage doors, wood, or cardboard to make shacks.</p> <p>Since 2000, Kingdom Builders Ministry has built 43 churches & over 750 homes surrounding Tijuana. Most of these families aren't able to afford to send their kids to school past the 6th grade.
