This Sermon Discussion Guide is only a tool to aid you in meeting the needs of your group. For most groups, there are too many questions to answer in one session together. Give priority to the needs and pace of your group members.

While the questions are important, remember your group's goal is to create an atmosphere that will foster true friendships. Use the discussion questions as you see fit but emphasize the relationships.

We fight with weapons that are different from those the world uses. Our weapons have power from God that can destroy the enemy's strongholds.

There's a lot of butterknife Christians out there because they've never picked up spiritual weapons before. They have them available but they never use them, so they take a beating that God never intended.

Then Jesus told his disciples a parable to show them that **they should always pray** and never give up....

Prayer is eternal. Prayer has no "shelf life."

The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results.

THREE WAYS THAT PRAYER WORKS IN YOUR LIFE—

1. Prayer releases God's good plans into your life.

[Jeremiah 29:12-13, AMP]

Then you will call on Me and you will come and pray to Me, and I will hear your voice *and* I will listen to you. Then, with a deep longing, you will seek Me *and* require Me as a vital necessity and you will find Me when you search for Me with all your heart.

[Matthew 21:22, CEV]

"If you have faith when you pray, you will be given whatever you ask for."

[Matthew 7:7]

"Keep on asking, and you will receive what you ask for. Keep on seeking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened to you"

[1 John 5:14-15]

This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us.

And since we know he hears us when we make our requests, we also know that he will give us **what we ask for**.

[Psalm 2:9]
