USING THIS SERMON DISCUSSION GUIDE

We have provided all the Scriptures references in the sermon and some discussion questions for you to use to facilitate a discussion.

This Sermon Discussion Guide is only a tool to aid you in meeting the needs of your group. For most groups, there are too many questions to answer in one session together.

While the questions are important, remember your group's goal is not to get through the questions, but to create an atmosphere that will foster true friendships. Use the discussion questions as you see fit but emphasize the relationships.

Mission of TFH: “The Father’s House exists so that those who are far from God will find life in Christ”

[Matthew 28:18-19]

“Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit”

God hasn’t called us to go in our own strength. He has designed us to be empowered by the Holy Spirit.

4 Reasons We Don't "Go"—

1. Our lives are full.
2. We don't think we can afford it.
3. Our pace of life makes us tired.
4. We don't think it will do any good.

FOR MONDAY—

1. Pray about a way that you can take action locally and globally. (prayer, financial support, social justice, etc.)
2. Take a next step toward serving your “Samaria”: pray for a softened heart, jot down what would build a bridge, or evaluate what needs might be there.

TALK IT THROUGH

1. Where are some places to which you have travelled with a specific purpose (non-leisure)? What were you hoping to accomplish?
2. What does it look like to live for the bigger picture?
3. Considering Acts 1.8, what are your Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and ends of the earth (your local place, your greater region, a place or people with which you have apprehension, and somewhere far away)?
4. Who are some people that have carried the Gospel to you? What did that look like?
5. When have you felt empowered by the Holy Spirit to share your faith? What led into those conversations?
6. Pray that God would never let the impact in our communities and partner nations grow old in our hearts. Ask God to keep our giving, our going, and our growing in obedience sacred and sacrificial.
