USING THIS SERMON DISCUSSION GUIDE

We have provided all the Scriptures references in the sermon and some discussion questions for you to use to discuss the weekend message.

This Sermon Discussion Guide is only a tool to aid you in meeting the needs of your group. For most groups, there are too many questions to answer in one session together. Give priority to the needs and pace of your group members.

While the questions are important, remember your group's goal is to create an atmosphere that will foster true friendships. Use the discussion questions as you see fit but emphasize the relationships.

[Isaiah 9:1-2, 6-7]

Nevertheless, that time of darkness and despair will not go on forever. The land of Zebulun and Naphtali will be humbled, but there will be a time in the future when Galilee of the Gentiles, which lies along the road that runs between the Jordan and the sea, will be filled with glory. The people who walk in darkness will see a great light. For those who live in a land of deep darkness, a light will shine. For unto us a Child is born,

Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever.

[Matthew 1:20-21]

“Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will give birth to a son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins.”

Jesus / Yeshua = Yahweh Saves (the deliverer and savior)

[Colossians 2:9]

For in Him all the fullness of Deity (the Godhead) dwells in bodily form [completely expressing the divine essence of God].

[Genesis 28:13]

There above it stood the LORD, and he said: “I am the LORD (JEHOVAH) , the (Elohim) God of your father Abraham and the (Elohim) God of Isaac.

[Isaiah 52:6]

But I will reveal my name to my people, and they will come to know its power.

(Know = through acquaintance and experience)

1. Bring your spiritual battles under the name, JEHOVAH-NISSI = (The Lord is my Banner)

[Exodus 17:14-15]

Then the LORD said to Moses, “Write this on a scroll as something to be remembered and make sure that Joshua hears it,... And Moses built an altar and called it (Jehovah-Nissi) The LORD is my Banner.

[Proverbs 18:10]

The name of the LORD is a strong tower; (a fortress) the righteous run into it and are safe (set high above the enemy).

THE NAME OF THE LORD: STRONG TOWER

- 2. Bring your lack of provision under the name JEHOVAH-JIREH = The Lord my provider (see Genesis 22)**
- 3. Bring your sickness and brokenness under the name, JEHOVAH-ROPHE = The Lord Who Heals you (See Exodus 15:26)**
- 4. Bring your anxiety, fear and stress under the name, JEHOVAH-SHALOM = The Lord our Peace (see Judges 6:24)**
- 5. Bring your hardest decisions and dilemmas under the name, WONDERFUL COUNSELOR**

Wonderful Counselor

Wonderful = (something beyond our understanding; a marvel)

Counselor = (the one who gives direction, purpose and clarity)

Key Points:

1. Bring your spiritual battles under the name, JEHOVAH-NISSI
2. Bring your lack of provision under the name JEHOVAH-JIREH
3. Bring your sickness and brokenness under the name, JEHOVAH-ROPHE
4. Bring your anxiety, fear and stress under the name, JEHOVAH-SHALOM
5. Bring your hardest decisions and dilemmas under the name, WONDERFUL COUNSELOR

Application for the Week:

5. What is the authority over your life? How can we position ourselves to be under the name of the Jesus?
6. How have you seen God as Jehova Jireh provide for you or those around you?
7. Considering the definition of Wonderful Counselor, what is one thing you can begin to personally practice to grow in relationship with God?
8. Who continues to model relationally living in the peace of God despite the circumstances surrounding him or her?
