USING THIS SERMON DISCUSSION GUIDE

We have provided all the Scriptures referenced in the sermon and some discussion questions for you to use to facilitate a discussion.

This Sermon Discussion Guide is only a tool to aid you in meeting the needs of your group. For most groups, there are too many questions to answer in one session together.

While the questions are important, remember your small group's goal is not to pound through the questions but to create an atmosphere that will foster true friendships, so knock yourself out with the discussion questions but spend more time laughing than answering the questions.

When God revealed His future for Abram, He told Abram to come out of his tent and look to the skies. We want to be a people who will seek the "Outside the Tent" moments with God.

How can we walk into our inheritance?

[Acts 20:32]

““And now I entrust you to God and the message of his grace that is able to build you up and give you **an inheritance with all those he has set apart for himself.**”

[Genesis 15:1,5-6]

“Some time later, the LORD spoke to Abram in a vision and said to him, “Do not be afraid, Abram, for I will protect you, and your reward will be great.”

Then the LORD took Abram outside and said to him, “Look up into the sky and count the stars if you can. That’s how many descendants you will have!” **And Abram believed the LORD**, and the LORD counted him as righteous because of his faith.”

Believe It!

“By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, **obeyed and went**, even though he did not know where he was going.”

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. **What is your inheritance? What are the promises of God for you and your family that you are contending for?**

- 2. Why is it so hard for us to believe in the preferable future God has for us?**
- 3. What has God spoken over you that requires your obedience? What can you do this week to move in that obedience?**
- 4. Have you taken your place in His Kingdom? Have you moved from spectator to participator from being a casual visitor to being a child of God? Is the church you attend only that... Or do you see it as the hope of the world of which you are a champion of?**
- 5. Who can you bring to church with you next week, which neighbor has God positioned for you to invite next week? Let's be the Church, the Bride of Christ and let's introduce a lost and hurting world to our savior. Spend some time praying for them by name, that God will prepare their hearts to say yes to His invitation.**
